

# COLONEL FOR A KNOCKOUT.

War Will Be Settled by Fighting Americans, He Declares.

MILWAUKEE, Wis., May 29.—“ We've got one grand duty, to put the war through—to a knockout,” said Colonel Roosevelt, speaking here this afternoon under the auspices of the National Security League. “ This war is going to be settled by the fighting Americans, who will take the burden off the shoulders of our allies.”

The Colonel made an appeal to mothers of German birth or parentage to bring their children up as Americans and to educate them in this country.
